A few highlights of the new website are as follows:



PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS QTR 1 FY23 OF SUPPLY, OPERATIONS, AVIATION, MARINE & EXPORTS, AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT & CONSTRUCTION DEPARTMENTS

- PSO successfully managed the products requirement as per sales/demand and stocks during the economic uncertainties and flood situation across the country that resulted in sudden decrease in overall demand for POL products and caused major supply shocks. PSO took several prompt corrective measures including rationalization of imports efficiently by deferment/cancellation of several HSD and Mogas cargoes & tenders and also realigned upliftment of products from local refineries. Such measures resulted in minimizing the overstocking to the extent possible and avoidance of huge demurrages exposure due to massive demand decrease.
- PSO, keeping in view the national interest and precarious flood situation in the country, also played its part in reducing country's imports bills during the quarter by strategically planning and rationalizing overall imports and minimizing foreign exchange outflow.
- PSO remained the only OMC to resume regular Mogas transhipment through White Oil Pipeline (WOP) during the quarter, and as many as five imported Mogas cargoes were transhipped through pipeline to up-country locations which ensured safe and uninterrupted supplies of Mogas as the movement of Tank Lorries remained affected during the period of excessive rain and floods. The transhipment of Mogas through pipeline also resulted in significant saving of freight cost that ultimately benefited the consumers.
- In order to timely identify supply chain issues and digitalize the whole process so as to respond proactively, the blueprint/draft of digitalizing the overall supply chain process has been reviewed and finalized which is under review with BPR team for implementation.
- PSO maintained its leadership position in Jet Fuel by achieving market share of 96.6% during the quarter under review.
- PSO Aviation sold 147,540 MT Jet Fuel with growth of 17%.
- PSO Aviation Increased profitability by achieving gross margin of Rs. 1,228 mn. An increase of 67%.

• Five new international customers added in Aviation customer base


- In Marine business, PSO maintained 100% supply of specialized HSD to the entire Pakistan Naval fleet.
- PSO Aviation achieved a growth of 59% by selling 14,000 MT HSD whereas, 87% growth also registered in HSD profitability by earning gross margin of Rs. 166 mn. Additionally, earned Rs. 3.0 mn in respect of Pakistan Navy hospitality charges.
- Development of new storage tanks (91,000 MT) at following locations are in progress for the future upgradation of storage capacity.

Fagirabad: Two storage tanks having capacities 15,000 MT (PMG) and 10,000 MT (HSD)

Mehmoodkot: Four storage tanks having capacities 24,000 MT (PMG) and 22,000 MT (HSD)

Faisalabad: One storage tank having capacity 20,000 MT (PMG)

• In the 1st Quarter, PSO completed rehabilitation of 2 storage tanks at KTB and Mehmoodkot having a total capacity of 3.96 KMT. In addition, 4 tanks are under rehabilitation at KTA and ZOT having a cumulative capacity of 74.9 KMT. Moreover, construction works have started in full swing at Faqirabad, Faisalabad, and Mehmoodkot for new storage development of 89.7 KMT.



TESTING CAPABILITY ENHANCEMENT OF MACHIKE AND LALPIR LABORATORIES

Testing capability of Machike and Lalpir Laboratories was enhanced to ensure gasoline in accordance with Euro-V specification by introducing sophisticated equipment "FTIR Fuel Analyser" which measures benzene contents and oxygenates (methanol, ethanol, MTBE etc.) in the Motor Gasoline according to the ASTM D-6277 and ASTM D-5845 respectively.



ANNUAL SUMMER INTERNSHIP

PSO's annual summer internship started on 18th July and ended on 26th August in fiscal year 2022-2023. Students from various prestigious universities such as IBA, IOBM, SZABIST, GIK, and NUST were selected for this project-based internship. PSO on-boarded a professional distributor M/s Trax for Hi-Street lubricant sales under a long-term business relationship. The agreement was executed on 12th August, 2022. The distributor will operate in all four south zone divisions i.e. Karachi, Hyderabad, Sukkur and Quetta.



This is the first time in the company's history that a professional distributor on-boarded to manage lubricant's hi-street sales. The on-boarding process involved a detailed exercise of evaluating different top-notch distributors against an approved evaluation criterion.

A distributor onboarding event was organized to officially kick-off the proceedings, attended by renowned retailers and wholesaler from Karachi and Hyderabad.



It is envisaged that the new distributor will assist in increasing the availability, coverage, visibility and brand-building of the company's lubricants while providing an opportunity to gauge pulse of customers through secondary sales software.

INSTALLATION OF NEWLY DESIGNED MONOLITH TOWERS

PSO installed 40 newly designed monolith towers at main business sites in South, Central and North zones. These monoliths are provided with ACM(Aluminium Composite Material) and digital price display with backlit LEDs for greater visibility at night.

Project for installation of ACM on CF/COCO retail outlet buildings is in progress for better maintainability and reduction in upkeep cost of the outlets. In 1st Quarter, buildings at 34 sites have been provided with ACM and completion of more sites is underway.





MOTOR DOC - 6 POINT VEHICLE HEALTH CHECK

The purpose of 6-point vehicle health check was to enhance and uplift the customer experience at our forecourt by providing a free 6-point vehicle health check.

The salient features of the campaign were as below:

Battery – Get your battery water topped-up and battery charge checked by Hydrometer reading. Also get to know that the battery connections are clean, tight and corrosion-free. Because batteries don't always give warning signs before they fail!

Tyre – Have tyre pressure checked and topped up.

Engine Oil - Get your engine oil level checked. Also get recommendation on the most suitable Lubricant from PSO Carient Motor oil product line

Brake Oil - Have the Brake Oil of your vehicle checked as it is critical to vehicle safety

Air Filter - Air filters prevent dirt getting into the engine. Get your filter checked and cleaned and know if it needs to be changed

Wiper Blades – Know if your vehicle wiper blades are torn, cracked or don't properly clean your windshield as the rainy season was underway!

The activity was run on 24 Forecourts in Karachi, Lahore, Islamabad, Multan, Faisalabad and Peshawar for a period of 1 week at each outlet.

During this period, we conducted a total of 18,760 customer interceptions and 3,789 successful Motor Doc checks along with 437 oil changes bringing happiness and satisfaction to our valued customers!

ISO 45001 CERTIFICATION OF PSO TERMINALS

ISO 45001:2018 is the latest international ISO standard which specifies requirements for an effective Occupational Health and Safety (OH&S) Management System. The standard gives guidance for its use in order to enable organizations to provide safe and healthy workplaces by preventing work-related injury and ill health, as well as by proactively improving its OH&S Performance. Key elements of this certification are leadership, planning, operation, performance evaluation, and improvement.

Three facilities of PSO namely Zulfiqarabad Oil Terminal, Machike Terminal, and Sihala Terminal have received certification of ISO 45001:2018 with strenuous efforts from Operations and HSE Team.

PROCESS SAFETY MANAGEMENT

Process Safety Management plays a pivotal role in order to ensure operational HSE parameters. Important elements of Process Safety Management were continuously implemented at PSO facilities including Permit to Work, Management of Change, Emergency Response, Safety Critical Equipment etc. to make our operations safer and accident free.

Following MOC cases were approved by MOC Committee in Q1 after rigorous review:



EMERGENCY RESPONSE DRILLS

One of the key elements of Process Safety Management is emergency response with respect to incidents like fire, oil spill, medical emergencies etc. The emergency drills were conducted at facilities to keep the staff and Emergency Response Teams prepared for any unforeseen incidents. These drills are conducted on a monthly basis to rehearse emergency preparedness, identify weak points and suggest possible improvements.







EMERGENCY EVACUATION DRILL

A planned emergency evacuation drill was conducted at PSO divisional office Lahore on September 16, 2022, in order to rehearse the emergency preparedness of staff and ensure an effective evacuation plan in case of emergency. Multiple areas for improvement were suggested by HSE Central Team post this drill so as to drive the continuous improvement process.

HSE LEARNING SESSIONS FOR TANK LORRY DRIVERS

Learning sessions with tank lorry drivers were arranged in Central and South regions by their respective HSE teams to raise awareness of safe driving, company HSE policies, Emergency Response Procedures, and HSE Inspection Checklist for tank lorries. The incident learnings from recent incidents were also discussed with the drivers to avoid similar accidents.





HSE AUDITS

As part of PSO's Visible Leadership / HSE Walkabout Procedure, HSE department facilitated General Managers in conducting facilities and retail outlet HSE Audits by preparing an annual audit plan as well as briefing GMs regarding the HSE Audit / Leadership walkabout mechanism.

This initiative will bring a positive cultural change at PSO's locations and will convey that the top leadership is fully involved and committed in resolution of the grass-root / ground level HSE issues and bring improvement in line with company's HSE policy, standards & procedures.



HSE AWARENESS SESSIONS AT VARIOUS PSO LOCATIONS

HSE regional teams delivered several Learning sessions across various PSO facilities, offices, and retail outlets. The sessions included topics related to Personal and Process Safety Parameters (PTW, MOC, RMS etc.), awareness related to HSE policies, systems, procedures and their compliance, firefighting, and emergency response. These learning sessions were conducted for PSO management, non-management, contractor staff, and retail outlet staff.





FIRE DRILL & H&S AWARENESS SESSIONS AT DIFFERENT AIRPORTS

A safe and healthy workplace not only protects workers from injury and illness, it can also reduce absenteeism and turnover, increase productivity and quality, and raise employee morale. In this context, PSO Aviation Operations carried out regular HSE activities at their respective locations. Accordingly, Fire Drill & H&S Awareness Sessions were also conducted at different airports.
















LEAP TOWARDS DIGITIZATION

Muhammad Saad Siddiqui, BPR & PMO department, completed Master of Engineering Management (Industrial Management) from NED University of Engineering and Technology.




