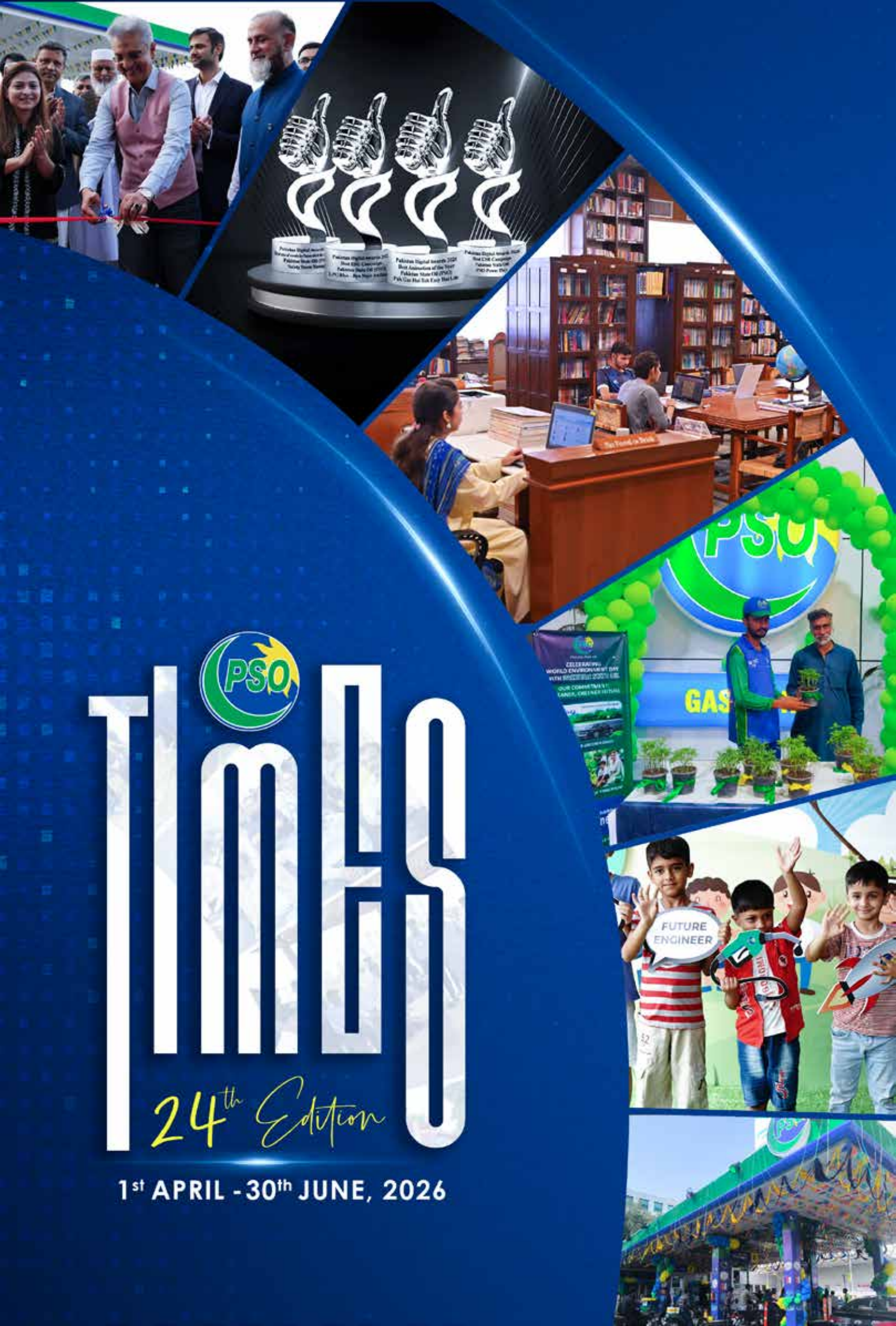

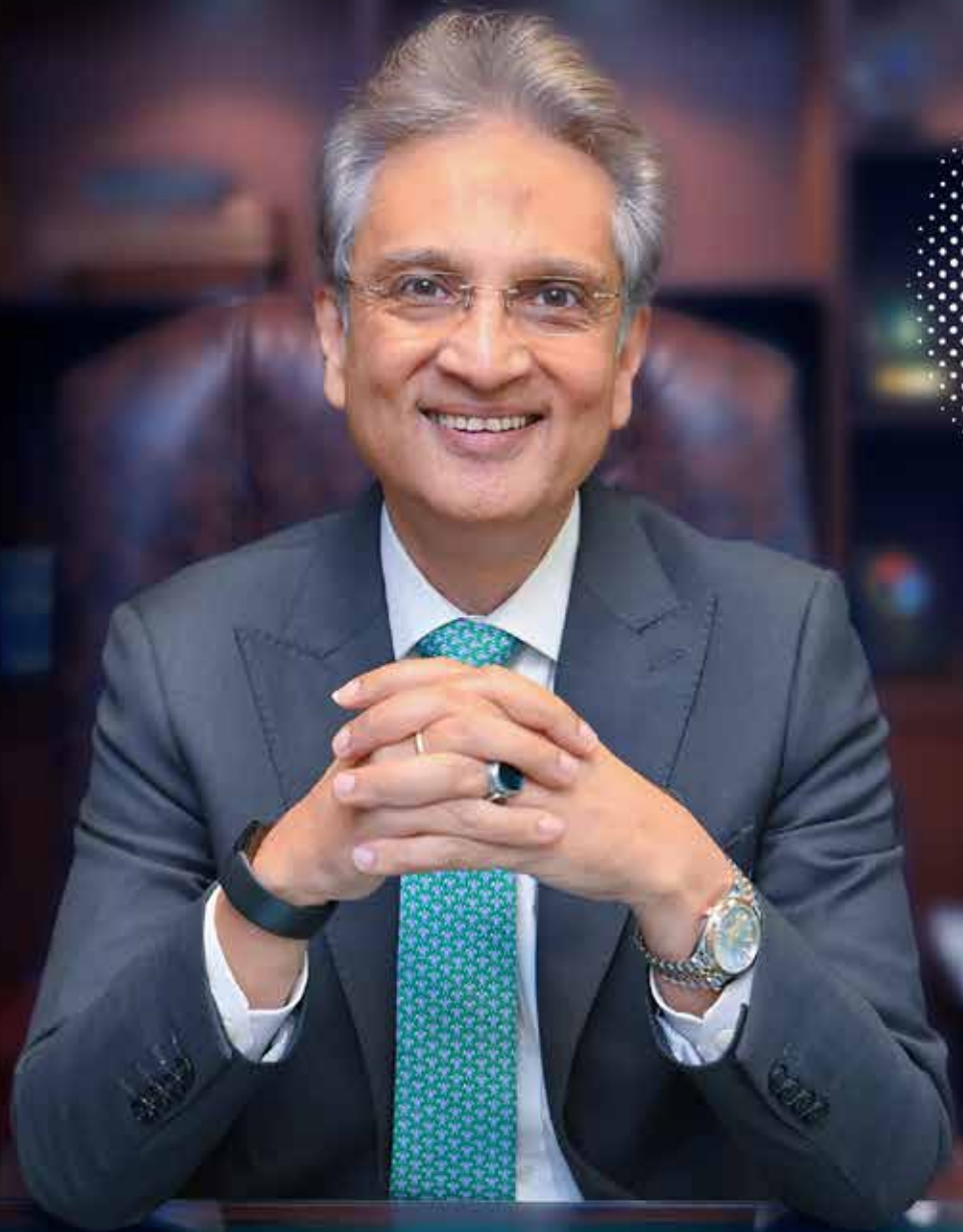

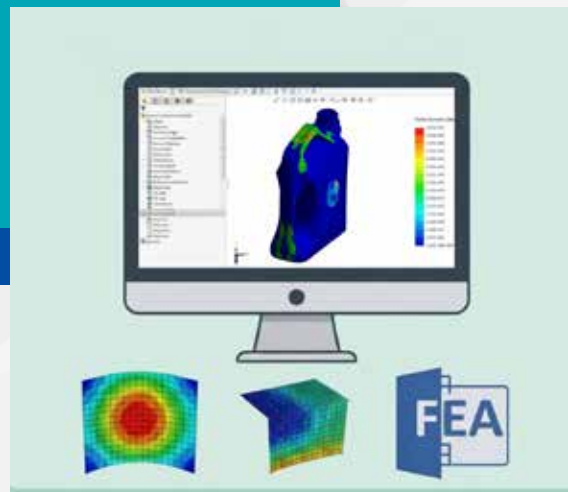

PSO's Administration Department has achieved a significant milestone with the attainment of the ISO 45001:2018 certification. One of the most respected international standards for occupational health and safety management.

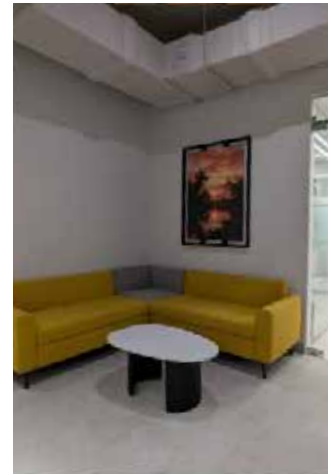

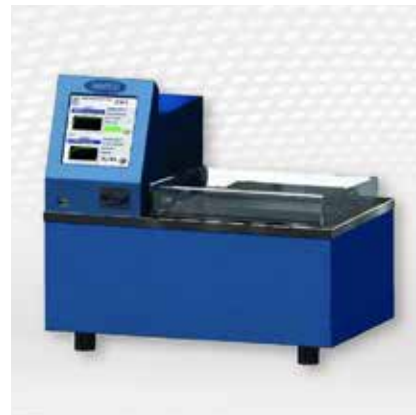
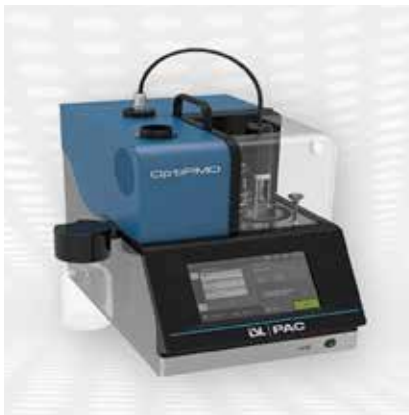
### National Fire Protection Association Training

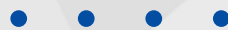
### QUALITY ASSURANCE



#### Driving Accuracy and Eco-Efficiency through Automated Micro Distillation

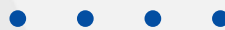
The KTA Central Lab has upgraded to next-generation automated systems for petroleum testing. The new micro distillation system, compliant with ASTM D-7345 and correlated to ASTM D-86, delivers fast, reliable analysis. Automated colour testing (ASTM D-6045) has replaced the manual D-1500 comparator, delivering consistent results within seconds and eliminating manual variability. Similarly, automated Reid Vapour Pressure (RVP) testing, compliant with ASTM D323, offers fast and precise results for gasoline, crude oils, and petroleum products through a dual-position, compact design.
