Drive in Foggy Condition

As winter time is on the way, foggy condition starts its stream into the environment especially in the morning time and mainly in Up-Country. Safety precautions while driving are much important in this condition. Keeping in view of the same following are some measures which may help in avoiding any type of incident/accident.

Before You Move!

- Check for weather conditions (Avoid traveling if Fog is extreme)
- Check brakes, headlights/backlights
- Clean the wind shield, headlights
- Make sure you know ups and downs of the road on which you will go through (please refer PSO's JRM Guidelines)



While Driving in Fog

- Always fasten Seatbelt and asked for the same to other passenger
- Turn your headlights on and make sure they are not disturbing your visibility as high beem of light will reflect towards you in foggy condition
- Try not to shut the windows fully, it will helps you to hear the sound of unseen traffic
- Drive in lane
- Use wipers if your wind shield gets wet
- Do not change lanes frequently
- Starts braking early if you have to stop
- Do not stop on a freeway or heavily traveled road
- Signal Turns well in advance and brake early as you approach a stop

Afterwards

- Practice parking etiquettes
- Get the vehicle issue resolved if any detected during a drive
- Try to back home early after office hours, so that the fog exposure will be less
